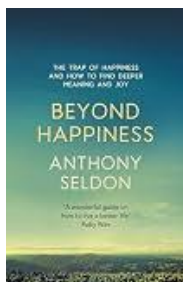

Beyond Happiness

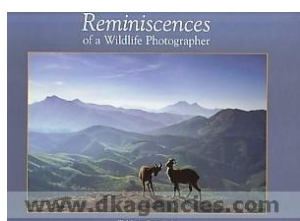

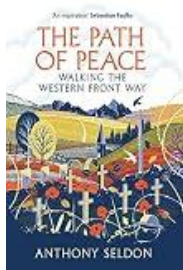

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The Path of Peace: Walking the Western Front Way

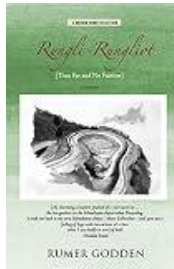

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Rungli Rungliot: Thus Far and No Further

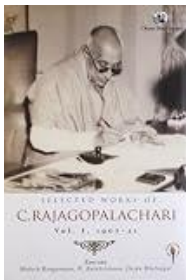
